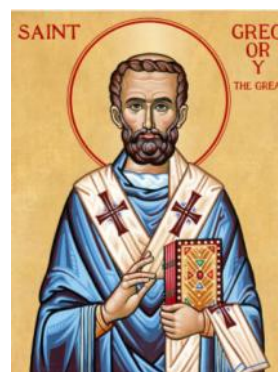

In preparation for the Eucharistic revival Event taking place in Indianapolis USA (Eucharistic Congress) July 17 to 21, 2024.

St. Gregory the Great Parish will participate in some events prior to the visit of Our Lady of The Cape. Our Blessed Mother is the Arc Of The Covenant and she always takes us to Jesus.

Consecration prayer to Our Lady of the Cape can be found in the pews or in front of the Arc. Write your petitions on the back of the card then place it in the Arc.

This Arc will stay in our parish until July 9th. At that time all the petitions will be taken to St. Ambrose where they will be placed into a bigger Arc and will travel to Indianapolis to be presented to Our Lord during the Mass.

June 15: A presentation of the film Bridge of Roses will follow the Saturday, 5pm Mass.

Light refreshments will follow the film.

June 26: Fr. Antonine Paul, OMI, will be our speaker starting at 7:00pm. "Mary guides us to the Eucharist" Light refreshments will follow.

July 6: Mini Pilgrimage to Guelph. The bus will be leaving our parking lot at 8:00am sharp. We will be visiting the Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate and attend the first Saturday devotion with Bishop Lobsinger. Returning at 2:30pm Cost of bus \$10 per person. Bring your own lunch.
