Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati: *He said that just as Jesus visited him every day in the Eucharist, he wanted to return the favor by visiting Jesus in the poor.* From In Caelo et in Terra: 365 Days with the Saints

Enthusiastically embracing a life of service, Pier Giorgio reminds us that the Eucharist is not a sacrament we passively receive but an invitation to a profound relationship with God and others that redefines the ways we give and receive love. Jesus gives us himself in the Eucharist. As followers of Jesus, we "return the favor" whenever we give our time, resources, and attention to others, recognizing that what we do for them, we do for the Lord (see Matthew 25:40). We can cultivate Eucharistic love in our families and communities in simple but profound ways, simply by being as present to someone as we would want to be with Jesus in the ways we listen to them, speak with them, and greet them.
