

In this month of the National Eucharistic Congress, we continue pondering the power of the Eucharist in the lives of the saints. Blessed Manuel Lozano Garrido shows us how Jesus in the Eucharist draws us closer to others. "As a young adult, his lifelong struggle with spondylitis.... confined him to a wheelchair. Manuel was able to continue his professional work as a journalist from his room. As his condition worsened and he lost the use of his hands, his sister Lucia became his assistant. ... Manuel's apostolate continued even after he suffered total blindness in 1962....

Manuel understood and related effectively with the world [as a journalist] because of his connection to Jesus, the source of life in the Eucharist. He knew intimately the joys and sorrows, the triumphs and tragedies of life and how God's love transforms them. —From *In Caelo et in Terra: 365 Days with the Saints*

Jesus holds every person—past, present, and future—in his Eucharistic heart. When we receive Jesus in the Eucharist, he mysteriously joins us to every person for whom he died. Manuel understood this. Like Jesus, he carried the joys and struggles of humanity as his own, and this inspired him to offer his prayers and his pen so that people would know God's love and accept his salvation.

Manuel's insights give us a Eucharistic way to read or watch the news. When we feel overwhelmed by the challenges and suffering in the world, we can bring the names, faces, and situations we carry with us to Mass, remembering that these are the very people for whom Jesus died—and for whom he still lives.
