

Mary knows sorrow. More than that, as the mother of the One who took upon Himself the devastating consequences of sin and the suffering it inflicts on each one of us—she knows *your* sorrow. She saw it reflected in her Son's eyes, and she bears it in her heart. Catholics have observed September as the month of Our Lady of Sorrows and the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows. Yet, we dare to proclaim the Cross as a "triumph." With Mary by our side, we find courage to believe in the promise of resurrection, even if our earthly vision is blurred by some very real tears. Precisely for this reason, Mary is a strong and faithful mother for us when the crosses of life feel too overwhelming to stand beneath.

In the book <u>Real Life with Mary</u>, Kelsey Gillespy imagines Mary not only at the foot of Jesus' cross but ours as well:

There's something about pain that pulls a woman's heart toward it. So, [Mary] stood, planted in place at the foot of the cross as they lifted [Jesus] high. Surely her heart ached as she reached for her Son, longing to console him.... And then it happened. Despite being in the capable hands and heart of his Father, Jesus called out for his Mother.

"Woman," Jesus called from above her, his blood pouring down the wooden pole. I wonder if she looked up into his eyes and found them full of anguish. I bet she would have done anything for him in that moment.... But Jesus only had one request. "Behold your son." He no longer wished for Mary to comfort him, but her new child. The child Jesus gave to her in that moment. His most beloved friend. You. Me. All of us.

So, today, as we carry our crosses through life, Mary rushes to our side. Perhaps her heart still squeezes inside her chest as she hears the cries of her children. I wonder if she looks into our eyes and finds them full of anguish sometimes. And, in those moments, I bet she would do anything for us—anything at all—so long as it brings us closer to Christ.
