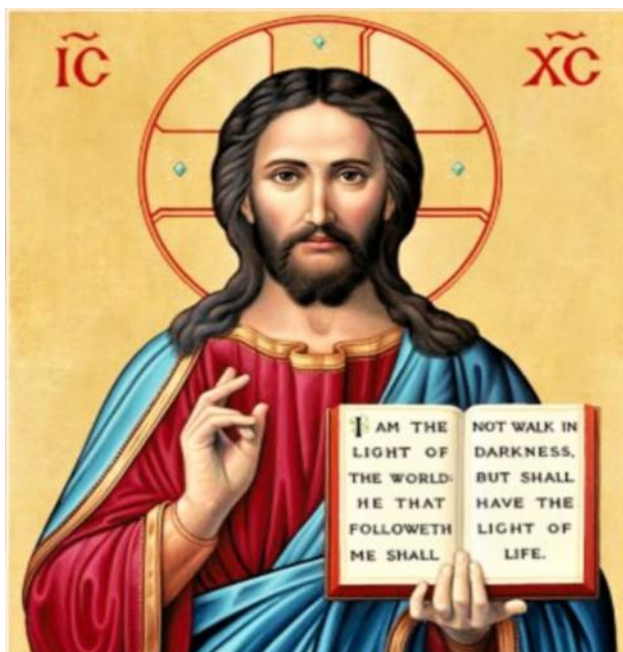

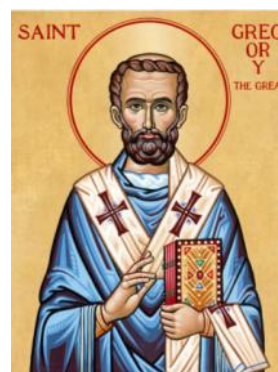

**CANADIAN FOOD FOR CHILDREN**

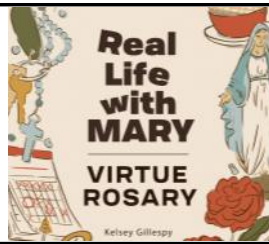
Is collecting clean flattened milk bags which will be made into mats for people in the third world . These mats become the only means of separating themselves from the ground.
