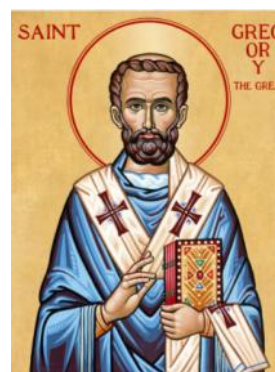

The month of November on the liturgical calendar has a somber spirit. It is a month of... well... death. We begin the month with the feasts of All Saints and All Souls, which remind us of our eternal destiny and our mortality; we observe Remembrance Day on November 11, and spend much of this month remembering and paying tribute to our loved ones who have passed away.
