



BLESSED CARLOS ACUTIS WILL BE

CANONIZED on April 27, 2025 in Rome. Blessed Pier Giorgio Michelangelo Frassati will be canonized on August 3, 2025, in Rome. Both events will be part of the **Jubilee Year of Hope** celebrations. The Jubilee for Teenagers in Rome takes place April 25-27 and the Jubilee for Youth (young adults aged 18-35) takes place July 28-August 3. Blessed Carlos will be the first "millennial saint"!

February 8, 2025

The Presentation of the Lord: The feast celebrates three main ideas. First, Jesus is recognized as the Light of the World, a light for all people. Second, it shows that Jesus came to fulfill the law, not to destroy it. He and His family obeyed the customs of their people. Third, it honors the deep faith of Mary and Joseph, who followed God's will at every step.

In the Gospel of Luke, we read about two holy people, Simeon and Anna, who meet Jesus at the Temple. Both Simeon and Anna see that Jesus is special. They have waited their whole lives for this moment. Simeon praises God and calls Jesus a "light for revelation to the Gentiles." This points to Jesus' mission to save not only Israel but also all nations.

The faith of Simeon and Anna reminds us to watch and wait for God's work in our lives. They recognized Jesus because they were close to God in prayer and worship. Through them, we see the joy of knowing and serving the Lord, even if it requires patience. We are called to "present" our own lives to God. Just as Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the Temple, we are invited to offer ourselves to God. This can mean letting go of selfishness, sacrificing comfort, or simply placing our lives in His hands.

This doesn't just mean going to church but offering our hearts, minds, and actions to Him each day. We are called to be humble, open, and ready to do God's will. This can mean making sacrifices, choosing what's right over what's easy, or simply asking God to lead us. young-catholics.com


